give unto my Wif's mother the summe of Two Guineas.  
Item I give unto M<sup>r</sup> Grisdale a Ring the value of Twenty  
Shillings. And lastly I give unto my two Men (If they are  
with me wher I dy) Jonathau Dilloughby and Iohn Leedy  
to each a Ring the value Eight Shillings. And of this my  
last Will and Testament I make and ordaine my fruely &  
beloved Wif Margaret Martin my full and wholt Executrix  
and doe hereby utterly revok all and every Testament formerly
