Allmightie God I John Sautaster of Wilverton in the County of  
Somerset being by a present weaknes under which I have for some time past  
and doe now labour more then an ordinary man to consider my mortality and the  
uncertainty of the time of my continuance in this life doe whilom I have in my  
and before I goe hence and be no more seen in my present memory published  
my last Will and Testament in manner and forme following I do hereby decess  
fully take heed in the doctrine and the discipline of the Church of England hoping to  
obtaine Everlasting life by the merits and mediation of Jesus Christ my alone  
Saviour and Redeemer and by faith in him And ad touching the disposing of my  
body after my death my desire and Will is that the same may be privately  
deposited in the parish Church of Wilverton without any noyse or other solemnity  
or Ceremony then is enjoyed by the Church of England And ad touching that  
part of my Estate which God is pleased to leave to my owne disposal I give and  
devise the same in manner and forme following I give and devise unto my  
loving wife for Unity and Twentie years if she shall soe long live the  
dwelling house wherein I now inhabite situate in Wilverton afor said and  
all the outhouses Courtes Gardens and parcells of Land ther unto  
adjoyning or belonging with all and every their appurtenances and all that  
Tenement and all those severall Closes and parcells of Land Meadow and  
pasture commonly called Ryvers with all and singular their appurtenances  
and the Will and Wishes thereon erected situate lying and being in the parish of  
Whelton in the said County And from and after the death of my said wife  
I give and devise my said dwelling house outhouses Courtes and parcells  
of Land with their appurtenances in Wilverton afor said and the said  
Tenement severall Closes and parcells of Land Meadow and pasture commonly  
called Ryvers lying in the said parish of Whelton and the Will and  
Wishes thereon erected with all and singular their appurtenances from the

Death of my said wife unto my Daughter Mary Lancaster her Heir and Assignes  
for ever And I have given devise and bequeath unto my said Daughter Mary  
Lancaster her Heir and Assignes for ever of all the messuages  
Lands Tenements Tenes and Hereditaments whatsoever  
situate lying being arising growing or renewing within the said  
Parishes of Wulborton and Wulby frombe or of either of them  
whereof or whereof I have seized Intereised or possessed or to which I am  
intereised for any term or number of years whatsoever And all my estate  
right title and interest whiche shall be to remaine in execution of my said  
Will and bequeath unto my Daughter Frances Lovell All the goods  
and chiefe helde stuffe now being in my Mansion House at Cheddre  
in the said County unexcepted in my sister in law Mary Lancaster her Heir  
doth now Inhabite I have also given five pounds to such of the  
parish of Wulborton as for said as my Executor herein after named shall  
think fit And to every of my servants who shall be living with me at the time  
of my death Twenty shillings a peice And I have unto my Brother in law  
John Scamman my best Coat and my best hatt my now with standing all  
my swordes and beltes and all the vestments I have which belong to my person  
and give to wear And I have given unto Elianor Widdow Do  
Robert Stancumbe and William Yewens five shillings a peice to John  
Ryfar of Cheddre five shillings and to Mary Chulrot and Elianor Chulrot  
five shillings a peice And as touching my said Tenement and Land called  
Lovers before devised to my said Daughter Mary Lancaster and her  
Heir as my intent and meaning is and shall here be devise and bequeath  
that my said Daughter Mary shall have to dy without issue  
that the same shall come and remaine to my said Daughter Frances  
Lovell and her Heir And my Will and desire is and I do hereby  
direct and appoint that none of my debts in my house at Wulborton  
shall be paid for payment of my debts if the same shal be demanded out of  
the residue of my estate and with what I have sold a part to raise monie  
towards the satisfaction of the same and that here in my goods and household  
stuffe in my house at Wulborton shall be used and enjoyed by my said wife during  
her life and from and after her death I give the same and all the rest of my goods  
and chattels unto my said Daughter Mary Lancaster her Heir and Assignes  
I have also devised Scamman the Elder my sole Executor of this my Will in trust for my said  
Daughter Mary until she shall attaine the age of one and twenty years And from  
and after that time I make the said Mary Lancaster my Executor And I do  
appoint and direct that my said Executor in trust shall within six months out of my  
estate All such summe and summes of monie to be and towards as he shall see cause  
or occasion in or about the execution of the trust herein in him repeated And in  
Testimonie that this writing doth containe my last Will and Testament I have  
hereunto and unto a Duplicate thereof which I appoint to remaine in the hands of  
my said Executor in trust for the use of my said Executor set my hand and Seale  
the third and twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand six  
hundred and sixty The mark of John Lancaster signed sealed and  
published by me above named John Lancaster to be his last Will open the  
day and year above written in the presence of us the subscribers and named as  
Witnesses hereunto in his presence William Widdow Do Thomas Widdow  
Doel Yewens Do Scamman
