I Robertus Mordant Citizen and Skinner of London being weak &  
in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory praised bee God  
for the same. Doe make and declare this my last Will and Testament  
in manner following vix. In witness whereof I will that all my just Debts  
and funeral charges shall bee paid and discharged And I will that  
my Executor hereafter named shall lay out on my funerall one hundred  
pounds Item I give and bequeath unto my Coden Gilbert Abate all  
my Apparition ldotuss both linen and woollen plate brass and  
iron in and about my now dwelling house in the little Minorye  
give him alsoe my lease of my said Dwelling house which I hold  
from the lady Grandison late paying the rent and performing the  
Covenants in my lease I give to my Coden Edward Castorp ten  
pounds I give to Mr. Edmund Shrewwood of Elde in Norfolk  
fifty pounds I give to my Coden John Whately one hundred pounds  
I give to my Goddaughter Elizabeth Mordant ten pounds To my  
two two Goddaughters Elizabet three pounds apiece To my Godsonne  
Edward Shrewlock six pounds To Mr. Robert  
Gale six pounds To the poore of the parson of the chiche Minorye twelve  
pounds to bee distributed at a Retyng to each of the poore of the said parsonage  
to the Chichester and my Executor shall thynke most fit. And I  
will that my Executor shall at our Retyng lay out twenty shillings  
on a Collation for the said Retyng men on the day of our distribution  
I give to my now Mayd servant Mary deere five pounds To my  
said Servante I will that bee paid by my Executor as soon as money can  
be conveniently rayed out of my estate I give to the Company of  
Smyndes London two silver Canbards both together of the value of  
twentie and seaven pounds wher I will that bee presented to the said Company  
and have engraven thereon the Companye Chaine on the hands thereof  
R. M. to bee delivred to them at their Court of Chancery Item I give  
unto my Coden Elizabeth Shrewwood two hundred pounds to bee paid  
unto her at her day of Marryage And my Will is that my Coden John  
Whately as soone as money is rayed shall paye it forth at Chancery  
for her maintenance or keepe it in his owne hands vntill her Marryage &  
allowing her Interest for the same at five pounds ten shillings per Centu-  
re Elizabet Chene in case she shall happen to die before she attainted her  
said Marryage then I doe give Eighty pounds thereof to my Coden  
Gilbert Ward and Ninety pounds thereof to my Coden John Whately  
And the other thirty pounds thereof I will shall bee laid out for her funerall  
charges Item I give and bequeath unto my Coden John Whately his  
Executor Administrato and Assynd. All that my Mysnayt or  
Endement with the Appertaininge and all my estate title Interest and

Item of year forthcoming called the signe of the Cheyne or Ratte in Coracle  
London which I hold from the Company of Grocers London and now do sat  
in the possession of Samuel Spurte or his assignee as & paying the rent  
and performing the Covenants in my lease before I hold the same  
Item I give unto my Cozen Mary the daughter of Gilbert Ward her  
hundred pounds to bee paid unto her by my said Cozen John Abbeatley  
at her age of one and twenty years on day of marriage which shall be  
first happen out of the Mesuage hereby to him given And Integet  
in the mean time at the rate of five pounds per Cent per Ann for  
and towards her maintenance And in case the said Mary Ward shall  
happen to die before she attained her said age then I doo  
give and bequeath the said legacy of two hundred pounds as followeth  
vizt. one hundred pounds thereof unto the said Gilbert Ward her  
father and the other hundred pounds thereof unto my said Cozen John  
Abbeatley Item I will that my Cozen Gilbert Ward shall receive  
the rents and profits of my three houses in St. Mary Aldermary London  
helden by two severties leased from the Company of Skinners London  
Dated the fifteenth day of December 1683. During soe long time as he  
shall live of the termes of yeare as shall bee to come therein at the time  
of my decease bee paying the rents and performing the Covenants in my  
said houses And after his decease I give my said two leases unto his  
daughter Mary Ward shal bee paying the rents and performing the  
Covenants in my said leased on the lessed parte to bee performed till  
her death and remainder of my money goods chattells and estate  
leade Mesuaged lands Entiments and creditaments whichever  
my debts legaryes and fundall charged being first paid and satisfied  
give and bequeath as followeth vizt. one moiety or halfe parte thereof  
unto my said Cozen Gilbert Ward and the other moiety or halfe  
parte thereof unto my said Cozen John Abbeatley And my express  
will and meaning is that the said Mesuaged or Entiment bequeathed  
and entited of money before mentioned to bee hereby given and bequeathed  
unto my said Cozen Gilbert Ward and Mary his Daughter as given  
and bequeathed to them in manner aforesaid in the place and recompence  
of all pretensions and demands whichever my said Cozens Gilbert and Mary  
Ward or either of them their or either of their desired Executors or  
Administrators shall or may claime or pretend to have or to be upon all  
or any parte of the Mesuaged lands Entiments or Estate whichever  
whichever whichever I shall bee held or possessed at the time of my decease  
And as upon and under this Condition that if my said Cozens Gilbert  
and Mary Ward shall not upon request to them made for that purpose  
release all such right and title as they or either of them shall have or  
claime to have of in or to my said Mesuaged lands Entiments and  
estate whatsoever and doe all further Oll and Olls for Confirming  
thereto unto the person or persons I have or shall give and devide the  
same or if my said Cozens Gilbert and Mary Ward or either of them  
their or either of their desired Executors or Administrators or any other  
person or persons on their behalf or any of their behalfed or chayrons or  
under their title or Interest shall in any sort or manner whatsoever  
or howsoeuer claime challenge or demand any Estate or title either in  
Laws or Equity to or upon all or any parte of my said Mesuaged lands  
Entiments and estate whatsoever other then what is hereby to them  
given or shall Intecept or molest the title or possession of such personys

or persons to whom I have by this Will or shall otherwise dispose of the said  
premises that then and in such case I do hereby repeal and make void all  
and every testamento of the said Mardon or Testaments or writings and writing  
of money before by me by this my Will disposed of to the said Gilbert and  
Mary Ward or either of them And I do hereby nominate and appoint my  
said Cousin Edward Calvert Overseer of this my Will directing him to  
be aiding and assisting to my Executor with his best advice in the due  
execution of this my Will And I do make and ordain my said Cousin  
John Abbotley full and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament  
And do hereby revoke and make void all former Wills and Testaments  
by me heretofore made in witness whereof that said Robert Mardon  
have to every effect of this my last Will and Testament being contained  
in four sheets of paper set my hand and to the top and last sheet thereof  
my Seal this two and twentieth day of June One Thousand Six hundred  
fifty, and One, Robert Mardon. Signed, Sealed, Published, and  
Declared, by the said Robert Mardon to be his last Will and Testament  
in the presence of Edward Hobkirk, Timothy Elcock, Phillip Rogissar  
Audrey Collin, Mary Kent, James Starkland.

Item I give and leave unto Edward Lambeth of S. Martins near  
Aldersgate London Schrewe the summe of ten shillings of like lawfull  
money to buy a ring for him to wear in remembrance of me And all  
the rest residue and remainder of my estate monys & household stuff  
plate goods debts dues dutys and demands whatsoever  
I give leave dispose of and bequeath to my deare & belovd wife
